MANDATORY ONLINE TRAINING: *Becoming a Content Expert of Suicide Prevention* February 9 - May 17, 2020

- The online portion is composed of 6 bi-weekly learning modules, with Module assignments due every two weeks. All learning Modules and assignments are mandatory. *
- Coursework includes articles, viewing and submitting videos, case studies, discussion board and group discussion posts, group work, and module quizzes.
- To progress successfully through this course, each online Module must be completed before the learner may advance to the next Module.
- Readings and activities are estimated to require 2-3 hours of your time per week.
