Registered Nurse to Bachelor of Science in Nursing Online

Add to your credentials by gaining the leadership skills needed to continue and excel in a professional nursing practice. In this program, you will become acquainted with essential topics and processes in genetics, genomics, and molecular biology, familiarize yourself with concepts and trends in the local and national health informatics field, examine the foundations of leadership and management theories and concepts in a variety of healthcare settings, and study an overview of models and theories of vulnerability – focusing on social determinants of health, health disparity, and culturally appropriate strategies to address the effects of vulnerability.

About the Program

Courses are 7 weeks in length, and the fastest degree completion time is 10 months. Coursework is online, and 120 credit hours are required to graduate. The program includes 30 RN to BSN credit hours. Students will receive 19 credit hours for the NCLEX (block transferred at no cost) as well as credit hours from their Associate of Nursing degree (actual number depends on courses taken and what will transfer). 37 general education and 11 health science credit hours are also required; transferred credit hours from the associate degree may apply.

Master of Science in Nursing - Nursing Education Concentration Online

Help meet the demand for qualified healthcare professionals by teaching future nurses and adding valuable knowledge to the practice of professional nurses. You will also enhance your aptitude for instructing patients so they can take a proactive role in their own healthcare. This CCNE-accredited online program provides the boost you need to progress in your career. Curriculum emphasizes the development of expertise in teaching clinical nursing for a variety of educational settings and includes didactic, online, simulation, and research-based methods of instruction. In this program, you will have the opportunity to apply instructional theory and teach content to nursing students, practicing nurses, and patients.

About the Program

Courses are 7 weeks in length, and the fastest degree completion time is 12 months. Coursework is 100% online, and students must complete 11 courses totaling 33 credit hours, including four core courses (12 credit hours) and seven concentration courses (21 credit hours). 200 clinical hours will be required to complete the program.

Master of Science in Nursing – Nurse Executive Leadership Concentration Online

Open the door to exciting leadership opportunities when you prepare for high-level administrative positions in healthcare. This CCNE-accredited online program follows an interdisciplinary approach by combining curriculum from the Departments of Nursing, Business Informatics, Psychological Sciences, and Accounting and Finance. Interactive coursework emphasizes financial issues in healthcare, organizational culture and goals, budgeting, and how to assess data in order to facilitate changes in practice delivery.

About the Program

Courses are 7 weeks in length, and the fastest degree completion time is 12 months. Coursework is 100% online, and students must complete 33 total credit hours, including four core courses (12 credit hours) and seven concentration courses (21 credit hours). 100 clinical hours will be required to complete the program.

Master of Science in Nursing - Family Nurse Practitioner Online

Add to your professional nursing credentials and develop the clinical experience, knowledge, leadership skills, and confidence you need in order to diagnose and treat patients of all ages. Our CCNE-accredited FNP online program prepares you to provide a full range of primary healthcare services, make referrals, and serve as an educator, counselor, and advocate for your patients. Interactive coursework emphasizes advanced clinical pharmacology, human pathophysiology, diagnostic reasoning, and advanced clinical assessment. Topics in this FNP program cover pediatrics through adulthood, clinical residencies, and a capstone to synthesize your progress.

About the Program

Courses are 7 weeks in length, and the fastest degree completion time is 22 months. Coursework is 100% online, and students must complete 47 total credit hours comprised of eight core courses (24 credit hours), five clinical courses (5 credit hours), and six FNP specialty courses (18 credit hours). 600 clinical hours will be required to complete the program.

Master of Science in Nursing – Adult-Gero Nurse Practitioner Online and Master of Science in Nursing – Adult-Gero Acute Care Nurse Practitioner Online

Both of these online programs prepare you to deliver healthcare services to adolescent, adult, and geriatric patients. While working toward becoming a successful primary care nurse practitioner, you will also sharpen your aptitude for leadership and explore issues within today's healthcare system. Focus on the fundamentals of theory and research for an evidence-based practice, analysis and application of health data, and advanced clinical pharmacology for APRNs. Our Acute Care program prepares you to function in time-sensitive situations where quick intervention is imperative, such as emergency medicine and trauma/urgent care.

About the Program

Courses are 7 weeks in length, and the fastest degree completion time is 20 months. Coursework is 100% online. Adult-Gero NP students must complete a total of 43 credit hours, which includes eight core courses (24 credit hours), four clinical residency courses (4 credit hours), four specialty courses (12 credit hours), and a capstone (3 credit hours). Adult-Gero Acute Care NP students must complete a total of 46 credit hours, including eight core courses (24 credit hours), five specialty courses (15 credit hours), four clinical residency courses (4 credit hours), and a capstone (3 credit hours). 500 clinical hours will be required to complete either program.

Master of Science in Nursing – Psych-Mental Health Nurse Practitioner Online

This CCNE-accredited PMHNP online program prepares you to integrate the diagnosis, treatment, and management of mental health disorders for patients across the life span. This intensive program covers the full scope of mental health NP practice, which is why our PMHNP graduates have an impressive 100% pass rate on the ANCC Psychiatric – Mental Health NP certification examination. Coursework focuses on synthesizing neuroscientific principles, neurophysiological theory, psychopharmacology, and therapeutic methods.

About the Program

Courses are 7 weeks in length, and the fastest degree completion time is 22 months. Coursework is 100% online, and students must complete 46 total credit hours comprised of eight core courses (24 credit hours), five concentration courses (15 credit hours), four clinicals (4 credit hours), and a capstone (3 credit hours). 500 clinical hours will be required to complete the program.

Post-Master's Doctor of Nursing Practice Online

Practice nursing at the highest level with a DNP degree and become the leader every healthcare organization needs. With these top credentials, you can implement evidence into practice, educate new nurses, develop a deeper understanding of how nursing can influence today's healthcare system, and facilitate positive change. This CCNE-accredited DNP online program prepares you to lead with the discovery, integration, and application of knowledge. As a nurse leader, you can work to improve the lives of patients as well as healthcare organizations at a high level. Coursework focuses on the role and responsibilities of a DNP-educated nurse, financial aspects of medicine and healthcare, technology in advanced practice, and population health.

About the Program

Coursework is 100% online, and the fastest degree completion time is 20 months. Students must complete 10 core courses (30 credit hours) and a DNP Practicum/Project (5 credit hours) for a total of 35 credit hours. Courses are 7 weeks in length with the exception of DNP 896, which is completed over 16 weeks. If DNP 896 is not completed by the last semester, students may take DNP 897 as continuing credit to complete the scholarly project.

Bachelor of Science in Health Science Online

Get ready to make a difference in health science and to help fulfill the needs of diverse populations. Our accredited online program is designed for professionals with an associate degree in a healthcare discipline. The knowledge and exposure offered in this program prepare you for various roles within the healthcare system or to continue your education and earn a graduate degree. In this online program, you will build on your prior healthcare experience by adding multidisciplinary foundations and holistic knowledge. Curriculum focuses on leadership and management, research, global health, health informatics, management of chronic diseases, current healthcare trends, and cultural issues.

About the Program

Courses are seven weeks in length, and the fastest degree completion time is 12 months. Coursework is 100% online, and students must complete 11 core courses totaling 33 credit hours. Students must also complete enough general education courses to total 120 credit hours when combined with core courses. The 120 credit hours may come from a combination of transfer credits (from an associate degree) as well as general education courses completed as corequisites.
